



2011/2012 USDA DoD Student Lunch Program Eligibility Guidelines

All parents interested in applying for the Free/Reduced Lunch Program for their dependents must complete USAFE Form 400 which can be found on the FSS website, the school, or at the school liaison office in T-112. Applications must be redone every year. Parents who have had children in the program have 30 days after school begins to complete the application before child(ren) are taken out of the program. New students and those who have income/household changes may apply or reapply as needed. I will be examining the following areas of income in accordance with USDA guidelines.

Basic Pay
Basic Allowance for Subsistence (BAS)
Alimony/Child Support Received
Spouse Income
Military or Civilian Retirement
Additional Income, Including:
net rental income
net self-employment income (home business)
social security payments
dividends from interest, investments, etc.
military special and incentive/SAVE Pay
temporary lodging allowance

Look at your Leave and Earning Statement (LES) and other income documents. If your total monthly income **EXCEEDS** the amount listed below, based number of **FAMILY MEMBERS** (including yourself) in your family, you are not eligible. If your income **IS** within guidelines, you fill out the application and bring application to School Liaison Officer (SLO). Please bring a copy of your most current LES or any other income statements that are applicable. A letter of authorization will be issued within five working days.
