

Confirmed Positive for COVID-19

Isolate for 5 days

Notify supervision & Medical Aid Station

Released by Medical Aid Station Or regional health director **After 5 Days** No test required if symptoms subside

If still symptomatic: Continue quarantine/Isolation

Isolation / Quarantine

- You are not allowed to leave your residence or receive visitors
- Policy subject to change w/ guidance updates from DoD and Host nation

Guidance for Exposure to COVID-19

Identified Close Contact

Close Contact - FULLY Vaccinated (To include booster and/or recovering from Covid within 180 days)

Quarantine and testing NOT required

If symptomatic or become symptomatic:

- Active Duty: Contact Medical Aid Station
- Local Nationals: Contact Covid Line at 808 24 60 24

For the 14 days after being identified as a close contact:

- Member should use surgical mask in interior/exterior spaces.
- Limit unnecessary interaction.
- Avoid sharing domestic items
- Monitor for Covid symptoms; monitor body temperature daily.

Close Contact - Not Fully Vaccinated (Over 6 months of 2nd dose with Moderna/5 months of 2nd dose of Pfizer, or 2 months with Janssen)

Quarantine NOT required

Testing recommended on the 5th day

If symptomatic or become symptomatic:

- Active Duty: Contact Medical Aid Station
- Local Nationals: Contact Covid Line at 808 24 60 24

For the 14 days after being identified as a close contact:

- Member should use surgical mask in interior/exterior spaces.
- Limit unnecessary interaction.
- Avoid sharing domestic items
- Monitor for Covid symptoms; monitor body temperature daily.

If POSITIVE see "Confirmed Positive for COVID-19"

CLOSE CONTACT: identified as direct unprotected and prolonged (+15 minutes) with a + COVID-19

**** FULLY VACCINATED: 14 DAYS AFTER 2ND DOSE OF MODERNA/PFIZER OR 7 DAYS AFTER BOOSTER DOSE**
